Purpose

The Intermountain section AWWA Diversity Scholarship was created to encourage education and training in the field of water quality, supply, and treatment among minority students. The scholarship will give support to one outstanding minority student in that field.

Eligibility

Students are eligible to apply who are pursuing a water related degree in the Intermountain West and who are female and/or who identify as Hispanic or Latino, Black or African-American, Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, Asian, or American Indian or Alaska Native. Students who have been accepted into a program but have not yet begun coursework are eligible to apply. Students are eligible to receive an AWWA scholarship once per degree program.

Timeline

The application and all required supporting materials must be received by the Intermountain Section AWWA no later than November 2nd, 2010. The recipient will be notified and the award sum will be made available by December 1st, 2010.

Support Provided

This scholarship will be awarded as a one-time grant in the amount of \$1,000.00. All applicants will receive a one year IMS AWWA student membership and a one year subscription to *Journal AWWA*.

Application Requirements

Send all materials required in the application for scholarship in one document in a pdf. format.

Along with the attached application form, please send:

- A complete resume
- An essay regarding your academic interests and career goals and how they are relevant to water quality, supply, or treatment in the Intermountain West. Essay should be no longer than 2 pages double spaced.
- Two letters of recommendation

Selection Criteria

Members of the Student Outreach and Scholarship Committee of the Intermountain Section of the American Water Works Association will review all submitted application materials. Applications will be evaluated based on:

- The applicant's letters of recommendation
- The quality of the applicant's essay
- The applicant's potential to contribute to the field of water quality, supply and treatment in the Intermountain West
