Purpose

The Graduate Science and Engineering Scholarship was created by the Intermountain Section of the AWWA to encourage advanced education and training in the field of water quality, supply and treatment and to support an outstanding graduate student in that field.

Eligibility

Students are eligible to apply who are enrolled in a graduate science or engineering program in the Intermountain West and whose research interests involve water quality, supply, or treatment. Students who have been accepted into such a graduate program but have not yet begun coursework are also eligible to apply. Applicants for this scholarship are considered without consideration of race, gender, color, or creed. Students are eligible to receive an AWWA scholarship once per degree program.

Timeline

The application and all required supporting materials must be received by the Intermountain Section of the AWWA no later than October 31st, 2010. The recipient will be notified and the award sum will be made available by December 31st, 2010.

Support Provided

This scholarship will be awarded as a one-time grant in the amount of \$1,500.00. All applicants will receive a one year IMS AWWA student membership and a one year subscription to *Journal AWWA*.

Application Requirements

Send all materials required in the application for scholarship in one document in a pdf. format. Along with the attached application form, please send

- A complete resume
- An essay regarding your academic interests and career goals and how they are relevant to water quality, supply, or treatment in the Intermountain West. Essay should be no longer than 3 pages double spaced.
- Two letters of recommendation (submitted following the instructions next page)

Selection Criteria

Members of the Student Outreach and Scholarship Committee of the Intermountain Section of the American Water Works Association will review all submitted application materials. Applications will be evaluated based on:

- The applicant's letters of recommendation
- The quality of the applicant's essay
- The applicant's potential to contribute to the field of water quality, supply and treatment in the Intermountain West.

Letter of Recommendation Submittal Instructions.

Each applicant is asked to submit two letters of recommendation as part of the application process for the AWWA Intermountain Section scholarships. In most cases, those letters are written by an instructor or professor that is working closely with the applicant in an individual research program or course of study. It is common practice for the person writing the letter to submit it, without the applicant ever seeing that letter.

In an effort to help the scholarship committee match up the letters with the proper applicants in a timely manner, letters must be submitted in the following way:

- Sent via e-mail as a pdf file
- The name of the file as: letter.studentlastname.studentfirstname.initialofprofessor.
Example: letter.doe.john.pr
- Received by the deadline of Oct. 31, 2010.
- Sent to: nicoleb@ims-awwa.org

Please provide these instructions to any person that will be writing a letter of recommendation on behalf of the applicant. Letters not received in this format and via e-mail may not be matched with the applications and may not be used in the evaluation of the total application package. Thank you for your cooperation in submitting the material in the appropriate manner which will facilitate the review and selection process.
